

Development of Teaching Reading through Reading Strategies for Enhancing Learners Based Applied Linguistics

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Abstract

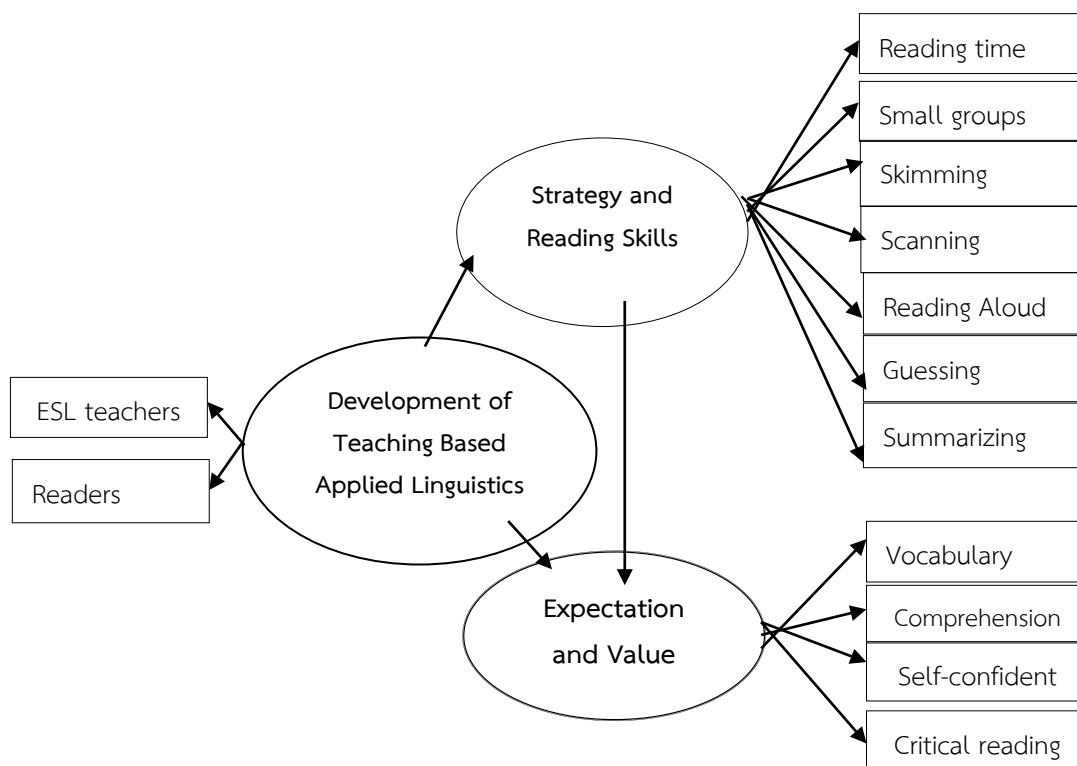
1. The reading material is easy.
2. A variety of reading material on a wide range of topics is available.
3. Learners choose what they want to read.
4. Learners read as much as possible.
5. The purpose of reading is usually related to information and understanding.
6. Reading is its own reward.
7. Reading is individual and silent.
8. Teachers orient and guide their students.
9. The teacher is a role model of a reader.

10. Reading speed is usually faster rather than slower.¹⁰ There was hugely helpful technique of independent reading material; it is possible to develop a language use of learners from discussing their thoughts and opinions. Due to the complexity of language, lecturer must be explained to students through the entirely reliable instruments. Skimming

Scanning

Scanning is a reading technique to be used when student want to find specific information quickly. As scanning a passage requires considerable skills "that reader seek to search for specific information without reading the whole text, through looking at its title, table of content."¹² In this regard, it is a tactic when scanning key words or idea of the text, reader directly concentrates on finding a particular context. It is an extremely save more time to read and do not need to read every words and sentences.

3. Developing readers expands their content knowledge and strategy opinion by embedding new information and strategies within their existing knowledge.¹⁵

Particularly, one of teacher's role in teaching and learning language need to apply psychological factors to teach through games and discussions instead of lectures,
