Journal of Studies in the English Language (jSEL) is a double-blind, peer-reviewed journal owned and managed by the Department of English and Linguistics, Faculty of Liberal Arts, Thammasat University, Thailand. The journal was established in 2003, under the name of Journal of English Studies. In 2018, the journal was renamed under its current title, so as to Journal of Studies in the English Language (jSEL).

We publish works written in English and on the topic of the English language, including empirical research, academic papers, commentaries, innovations in practice, and book reviews. We welcome work done by ASEAN scholars that focuses on the unique challenges and issues surrounding the use of English in this part of the world. We are especially interested in issues related to English language use in transcultural, translanguaging, and translational settings. These include works done in the following broad areas:

- English language teaching and learning
- Global/World Englishes
- Intercultural communication
- Literary & cultural studies
- Translation and interpretation

jSEL publishes 3 volumes per year, No. 1 during January–April, No. 2 during May–August and No. 3 during September–December.
